- 3) Pumpkins/gourds must be carved prior to bringing them to the contest area on September 26, 2015.
- 4) ***Carved pumpkin/gourd entries must be checked in at the Contest Tent (in south tent on Main Street – east side of Central Square) between 12:30-1:30 pm. People's Choice voting will be open from 2:00-4 pm.***
 - a. Bring completed entry form with carving to check-in area.
 - b. Winners announced approximately 4:15 pm from the Tulip Toren stage.
- 5) Prizes: First Place \$30 in Pella Bucks, 2nd Place \$15 in Pella Bucks.
- 6) The Pella Chamber reserves the right to publish and use any or all photos of entries/winners for any purpose including publicity, promotion, or advertising with no compensation.
- 7) The Pella Chamber is not responsible for lost, stolen, illegible, misdirected or late entries. By entering the contest, exhibitor accepts and agrees to these requirements and the decisions of the voting is final.
- 8) Employees or board members of the Pella Chamber of Commerce are not eligible for participation.
